Emmerson Honors 63 Women For Their Service To The Region

ONTARIO -- For each of the past five years, state Assemblyman Bill Emmerson, R-Rancho Cucamonga, recognizes 63 outstanding Inland Empire women

for their work and dedication to their communities. He honors them at a lavish, well-attended luncheon, singing their praises and allowing them to bask in their well-deserved limelight. This year was no exception as the tradition continued.

And although all the women celebrated at the luncheon are deserving, he does select one woman that stands out among them. This year, the woman of the year from Emmerson's 63rd district is Debbie Brown of Redlands. Brown is active in many nonprofit organizations including The Children's Fund of San Bernardino. She was honored in a special ceremony in Sacramento to earlier this spring.

"It is a privilege to recognize these remarkable women who have gone above and beyond the call of duty help others. They have truly made a positive impact in their community and de-

serve to be recognized," Emmerson said in a prepared statement. "Even though these women come from different backgrounds, the one thing they have in common is their ability to inspire others around them."

According to Kayla Garcia, a spokeswoman for his office, Emmerson sends out numerous inquiries to the cities, service organizations and nonprofits throughout his district, asking for nominations. The key criteria is service to community.

SENATOR DUTTON ADDRESSES THE CHAMBER ON THE STATE OF THE STATE

May 15, 2009

Sen. Bob Dutton, who represents portions of San Bernardino and Riverside Counties, including Rancho Cucamonga, in the California State Senate, was the featured speaker at the Chamber luncheon held at Celebration Hall in Victoria Gardens Cultural Center on May 15. The focus of his discussion was the State of the State and how the budget crisis is the primary focus of the



Legislature.

The Senator stressed that California must bring its state spending under control. Because of the size of the current deficit, now pegged at \$24 billion, Senator Dutton said the Legislature will have to make cuts in program spending. He said that making those program cuts may seem like a simple concept, but it's a

Senator Dutton Joins California Legislative Automotive Study Group



Job creation, economic stimulus continue to be focus for Senator Dutton

SACRAMENTO – As part of a priority to do everything in his power to help stimulate the economy and create jobs, Sen. Bob Dutton (R-Rancho Cucamonga) announced today that he has joined the newly formed California Legislative Automotive Study Group.

The group will be comprised of members from both the California State Senate and Assembly who will work together to promote and protect California's auto industry. The current recession has hit the auto industry particularly hard over the last several months.

“We need to do everything we can to help stimulate this economy and create jobs,” said Senator Dutton. “California has the second highest number of auto related jobs in the nation with more than 190,000 and many of these people have lost their jobs because of the economic downturn. We need to do what we can to ease the government burdens and regulations on businesses here in California in order to help them prosper.”

Ramon Alvarez, owner of Alvarez Lincoln Mercury in the Riverside Auto Center and Vice President of the California New Motor Vehicle Board, welcomes Senator Dutton's participation in this new Legislative group.

“I'm really glad Senator Dutton has decided to join the California Legislative Automotive Study Group,” Alvarez said. “We all know the automotive industry has been hit hard during this latest recession and would welcome fresh ideas to stimulate the automobile market. I look forward to

working with him while exploring new technologies and innovations, including hybrid, electric and zero-emission vehicles.”

Even before joining the Legislative Automotive Study Group, Senator Dutton introduced legislation that will help increase auto sales. Senate Bill 714 will allow for the value of a used car trade-in to be deducted from the sale price of the new car when calculating the sales tax. This type of deduction is currently used in 46 other states.

“Car sales have continued to fall and were off 43 percent year in California during the first quarter of 2009,” Senator Dutton said. “SB 714 will help provide an incentive for people to trade in their vehicle and purchase a new car.

concept many in the Legislature have failed to grasp. As a result, California continues to operate in the red despite raising taxes by more than \$12 billion in February, the largest tax increase in state history.

“Just 20 days after the Governor signed the historic tax increase, the non-partisan Legislative Analyst’s Office announced that the budget package passed by the Democrats was already in the red by \$8 billion,” said Senator Dutton. “And even worse, the Governor has said the deficit has now grown to as much as \$24 billion as tax revenues have not met projections”. Senator Dutton added that no one enjoys making cuts, but until more private sector jobs are created, the cuts are a necessary first step in solving the state’s ongoing fiscal crisis.

During his address at the Chamber luncheon, Senator Dutton stressed that it is vital to California that government also take the necessary steps to create a more business friendly environment to help generate private sector jobs. He said real wealth is created not with growth in the number of government jobs, but in generating private sector jobs.

“California has been too busy creating government jobs while

at the same time running private sector jobs out-of-state,” said Dutton. For example, he pointed out, from January 2001 through January 2008, the number of government employees in California increased by 171,400 while 132,100 private sector jobs were lost. Without allowing businesses to increase more private sector jobs, Senator Dutton said history has proven that California will continue to have a tax base that is insufficient to pay for necessary government services.

Despite the challenges he and the Legislature are facing in trying to solve the state’s fiscal crisis, Senator Dutton remains optimistic that California can lead the nation out of this recession by making private sector job growth a priority. Those private sector jobs will then produce the tax base needed to fund the vital government services that are now in jeopardy and that, he said, is the best way to speed up economic recovery and shorten this recession.

“The best social program California can provide is a good paying job,” said the Senator in conclusion.

Group Home Notification Bills Clears Senate Appropriations

SACRAMENTO – Legislation introduced by Sen. Bob Dutton (R-Rancho Cucamonga) moved one step closer to becoming law today. Senate Bill 352 will ensure law enforcement officials are notified before a juvenile offender from a different county is moved to a group home in their jurisdiction. SB352 passed the Senate Appropriations Committee today and is now headed to the Senate Floor for approval.

Senator Dutton became aware of the need for this type of legislation when in the summer of 2008, eight illegal alien juvenile offenders originally from San Francisco escaped from a San Bernardino County group home. The incident highlighted the relatively common practice of counties placing juvenile offenders in out-of-county juvenile homes. More importantly, though, it made county officials aware that other jurisdictions were placing juvenile offenders in their county without proper notification.

"This is a common sense measure that will protect the public and strengthen oversight of juvenile offenders who are placed in out-of-county group homes," Senator Dutton said. "It will ensure that what happened last year when our local county law enforcement officials were not notified won't happen again."
